The airframe is Depron, balsa, lite ply and fiberglass. A 6S battery powers the 80mm fan. Next, a Tower Hobbies Sport 60" belongs to Dave H. and is e-powered. A glow engine was an option to power the Sport. The final plane, a Skywing Yak distributed by Extreme Flight belongs to Paul S. It spans 60" and powered by an Extreme Flight recommended motor/ESC. Paul uses a gyro to assist with knife-edge flight. They all flew great.
